Renewal Terms	Upon completion of the Initial Term of a fixed rate, this Agreement will automatically renew on a variable month-to-month Holdover Rate at the same Terms of Service. Written notice will be sent at least 45 days prior to the renewal date, apprising you of any proposed changes in the Terms of Service of this Agreement and of your right to renew, terminate, or renegotiate this Agreement. The initial Holdover Rate for the first billing cycle will be noted in your Renewal Notice. If the Holdover Rate changes for any subsequent billing cycle, you will be informed of the new Holdover Rate at least twelve (12) days prior to the close of the current billing cycle. APG&E will provide such notice on your bill, in a separate mailing, or with your mutual consent, by email, text, automated phone message or other manner.
